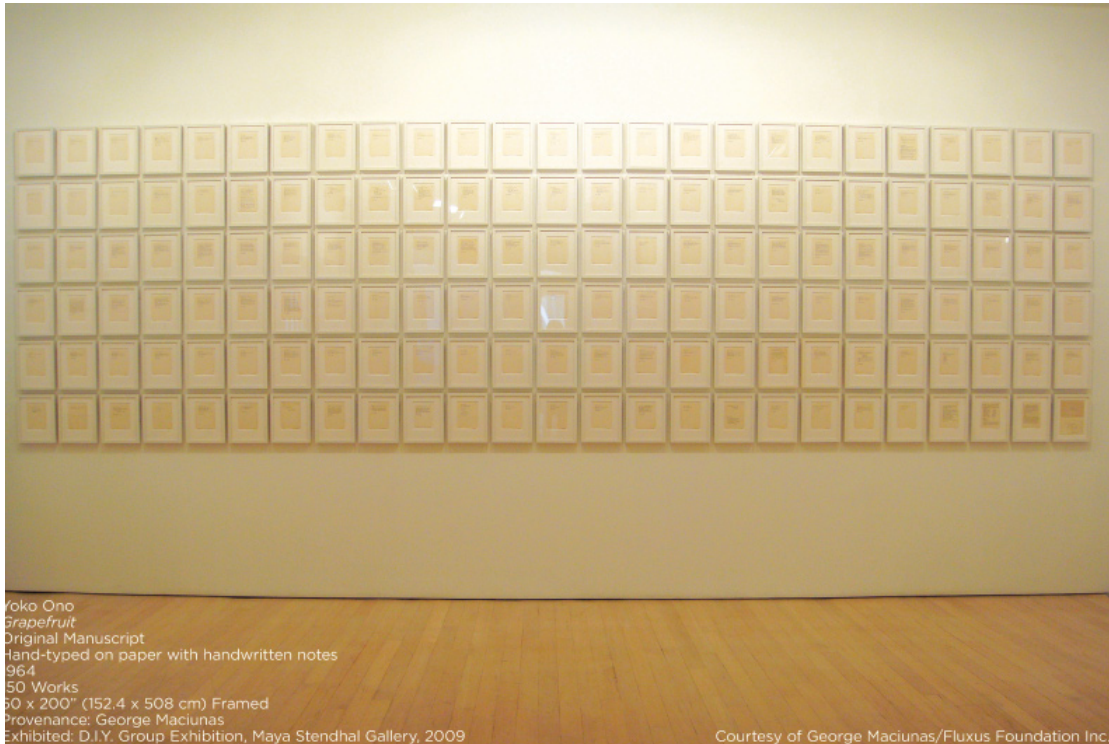


Gallerist Harry Stendhal Settles Lawsuit With Jonas Mekas and Anthology Film Archives

Sotheby's will auction Yoko Ono *Grapefruit* original manuscript

The filmmaker Jonas Mekas and his New York art dealer, Harry Stendhal of the Maya Stendhal Gallery, have settled a long running legal dispute, according to lawyers for the parties.
